Session Format Types:

Traditional Educational Session

• Propose a 20-minute session from any of the suggested topic areas. Typically, these sessions combine 3 speakers on common topics with a 5-minute Q & A time for each speaker.

Deep Dive Session

• Propose a 45-minute session from any of the suggested topic areas. This session is intended to cover an in-depth topic and allow more interaction and time for attendees to ask questions and discuss relevant topics. This deep dive session could be in a traditional speaker format or panel discussion format.

Lightning Round Session

• Propose a 10-minute session from any of the suggested topic areas. These sessions are intended to be lively and informative talks from several presenters in a 90-minute session format with 15 minutes for Q&A.
